Gastrointestinal Manifestations of Systemic Sclerosis

Esophageal involvement is very common in SSc. In an autopsy case series of greater than 50 SSc patients published in 1969, atrophy or fibrosis was detected in the esophagus in 74% (). When all cases of SSc seen at the Cleveland Clinic between 1952 and 1969 were reviewed, abnormalities were noted in 53% of the 233 patients who underwent barium esophagram ().

In the gastrointestinal tract, the esophagus is the second most susceptible to candida infection, only after the oropharynx. Immunocompromised patients are most at risk, including patients with HIV/AIDS, leukemia, diabetics, and those who are receiving corticosteroids, radiation, and chemotherapy.
