In 12 months, Timmy will follow 2-step directions, during large group activities (i.e., groups of 6 or more children), 1 time per observation period, across 5 consecutive group times. By November 1, 200X, when given a verbal direction by an adult, Robin will begin to comply with the direction within 10 seconds, 3 out of 4 opportunities, for 3 consecutive days.

Individual Evaluations and Eligibility Determinations

The determination of the need to conduct an individual psychological evaluation for school-age students must be made on an individual basis using a variety of data collection methodologies and information sources (e.g., analysis of the referral, interviews, observation, rating scales completed by parents, teachers and the student and a review of school records).
